Israel is not in Europe, it is in the Middle East occupying Palestinian land.

Why then does Israel play football in the European Cup, enter the Eurovision and have special status in Europe through the EU-Israel Trade Association Agreement?

This agreement offers to Israel full access to the EU scientific, academic, research and technical programmes. The EU trade agreement provides economic advantages to Israel and the EU continues the arms trade with Israel.

The EU is sending a message that it effectively condones the Israeli apartheid regime and that it will not challenge Israel on its massive violation of Palestinian rights, despite supporting UN resolutions condemning Israel's human rights violations, massacre of civilians, collective punishment, construction of settlements and the apartheid wall.

The European elections are on June 4th and we must ensure that candidates condemn the occupation of Palestine by the state of Israel and are willing to back those condemnations by calling for:

- Sanctions on Israel
- Suspension of the EU-Israel Trade Association agreement
- Suspension of all arms trading
- End to the siege of Gaza
- Insist Israel complies with international laws and human rights laws.
