In addition organisations supportive of the Palestinian people will have stalls around the square to distribute information around the issues facing the people in the middle east, as well as peace organisations campaigning not just for peace in the Middle East, but against nuclear weapons and all war.

Speakers will bring messages of solidarity that we hope will ensure the Palestinian people of our continued support in their struggle for peace and justice. Our event comes at a time when the situation in Palestine, particularly in Gaza is at crisis point, with people, especially children, starving, and dying due to lack of food, water and medicines. We are committed to raising awareness in the face of a daily hostile press and media.
